OFF LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **TK VINEYARD LIMITED (the licensee)** is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **190 TE RAHU ROAD, WHAKATĀNE** and known as **TK VINEYARD LIMITED**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may only be sold 'on line' or by telephone at any time on any day, and delivered from the applicant's premises to the buyer (or any other person on the buyer's behalf) for consumption somewhere else. No sales or supply may take place on the applicant's premises;
2. No alcohol is to be delivered to the buyer (or any other person on the buyer's behalf) on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, or Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day;
3. No alcohol is to be delivered to the buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time after 11pm on any day and before 6am on the next day;
4. The licensee must follow the procedures set out in Regulations 14 & 15 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations to ensure that neither the purchaser nor the person to whom alcohol is delivered is a minor;
5. At all times there must be a certificated manager properly appointed to the business by the licensee;
6. The licensee must state the licensee's name, licence number and the date the licence expires:
 - a. on every receipt issued for alcohol sold remotely;
 - b. in every catalogue if alcohol is sold by remote sale using catalogues;

- c. on the internet site if alcohol is sold by remote sale using an internet site;
 - d. if alcohol is sold by remote sale using an internet site, the site must also display either a legible image of the licence, or a clearly identified link to such an image.
7. The licence is to be endorsed "Section 40 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 applies".

PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from **TE RAHU ROAD, WHAKATĀNE** is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- (a) Until **24 May 2025**; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed

NOTE: this licence shall expire on the same expiry date (or anniversary) as that of the licence it replaces or, if renewed, of the most recent renewal certificate.

ADVICE TO APPLICANTS

It is the licence holder's responsibility to note the expiry date for this licence and to ensure any renewal application is lodged prior to the expiry date.

This Licence replaces Licence number 25A/CERT/20202/2021 issued by the Whakatāne District Licensing Agency
